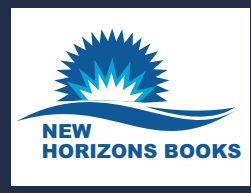

The books are filled with beautiful and expressive picture illustrations which will attract the interest of children. They have activities and worksheets which are meant to test their knowledge of all that have been taught.

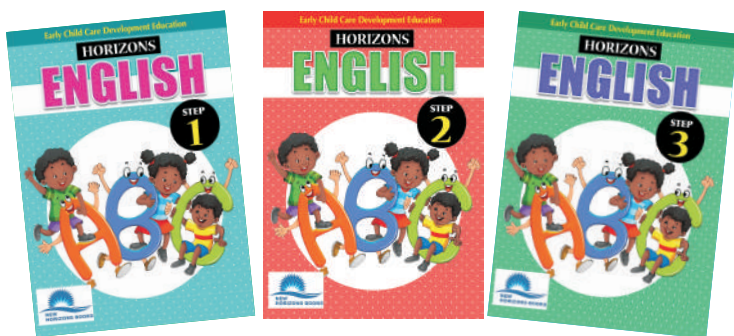
HORIZONS MATHEMATICS

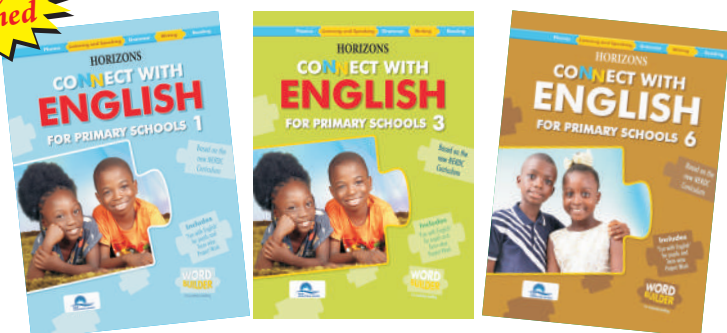

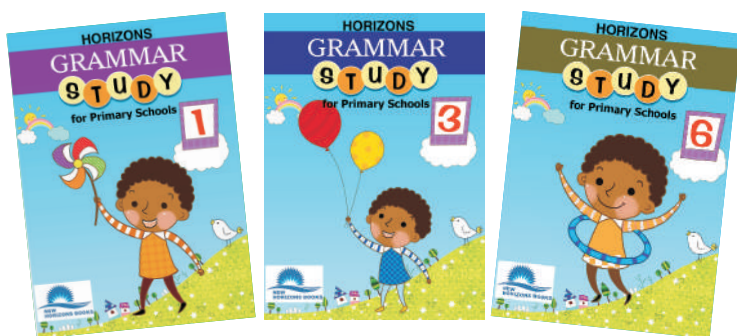

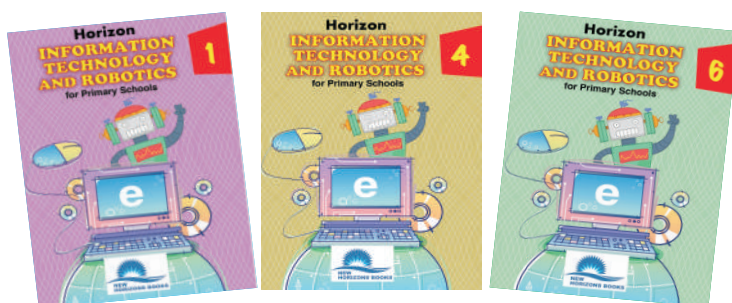


Horizons Phonics for Primary Schools Books 1-6 is a six-book series written for pupils in the lower and upper primary school levels.

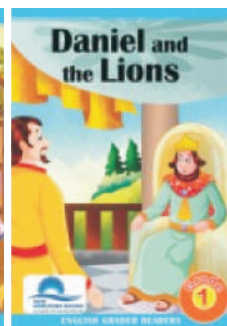
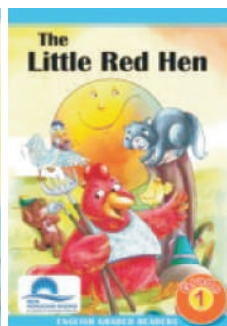
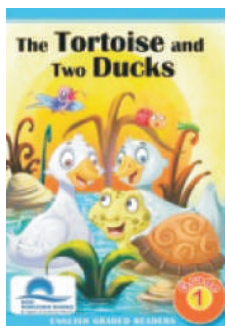
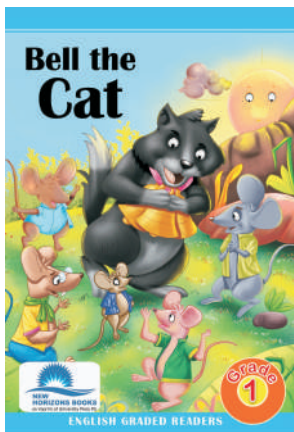
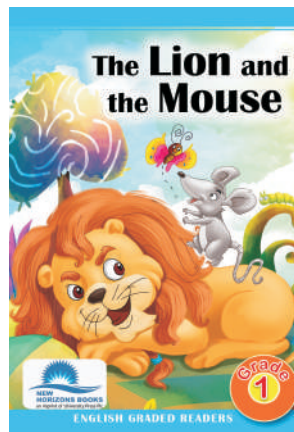
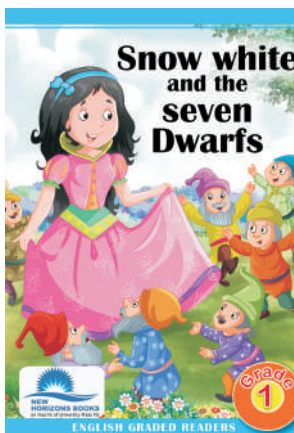
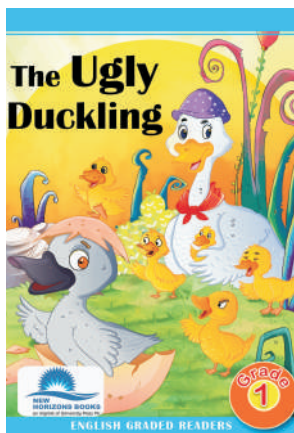
NEW HORIZON ENGLISH GRADED READERS
